Manipulation of public opinion and society !!!

Strategies and techniques usually used :

- The diversion strategy, chief element of social control

The diversion strategy consists in diverting public attention from important problems and changes decided by the political and economic elite's, through a continuous flood of distractions and unimportant information (e.g. surveys).

The diversion strategy is also essential to prevent the public from being interested in essential knowledge, in the fields of science, economy, psychology, neurobiology, and cybernetics.

To keep the public attention distracted, away from the true social problems, captivated by subjects of no real importance such as surveys for example...
