Big headaches in Combovin (France)

The workgroup of Combovin for the working of Internet informs that it will “complain against x” at the High Court of Valence.

The workgroup, an affiliate to the national association “*Robin des Toits*”, is also a member of the Drome-Ardeche Federation (*southern France*) of workgroups of phone masts residents.

This workgroup a been created in November 2006 after that numerous people from several districts of the village who have been exposed to the main beam of the wi-fi base station for high speed Internet access had experienced symptoms of electrosensitivity.

The symptoms are: insomnia, headaches, breathing problems, heart problems, and memory and concentration losses.

Several persons have had to go to hospital. These symptoms readily disappear beyond the exposition zone.

One family has had to temporarily move house and have their children change school.

Due to service malfunction, health problems and the now available high-speed cable Internet access (one month after the installation of the base station), all subscribers, including the local authorities, have resigned their contracts.

As this phone mast has become useless and a source a nuisances, the 120 people workgroup asked the operator to remove it.

Despite many calls issued by the General Council the operator presently “cannot be contacted”.

Therefore as we care for our health, we now have the obligation to officially complain to the Court.

The workgroup wishes to thank all the people who, in one way or another, bring their support us from the start of our action.
